OBI Active 8 - November 2017 Portfolio Update


Investment Objective

This type of portfolio is NOT a risk-free portfolio, rather, it is suitable for a client whose is prepared to invest into equities for the majority of the time and is focused more on the return than the risk, hoping that by doing this they can achieve greater medium-term returns. The portfolio is managed dynamically by altering the asset allocation using assets that carry market risk, and using all assets that are available from the investment universe. The asset allocation in this portfolio will vary between a benchmark of 0% equity and 85% equity to achieve the portfolio objectives, provided economic conditions permit. The portfolio will be managed to try and limit the *indicative capital loss in any 12-month period to 18% following a significant event and 9% in normal market conditions* and to target an *annualised total return averaged out over a full economic cycle (5 – 7 years) of 9%*.

The benchmark we use for comparison purposes for volatility is **AFI Balanced** noting this benchmark currently **holds 71.6% in Equity (1st November 2017)** and is therefore more aggressive and has no capital preservation mandate. It would be expected therefore that the benchmark would outperform the model and that the volatility would be higher. The model performance therefore cannot be directly compared to the benchmark.

Scatter Chart Reflecting Volatility and Annualised Return in GBP over 1 Year (launched March 2016)





Outlook & Positioning

OBI Active 8 is the most aggressive main stream balanced portfolios that is still considered balanced with regards to the underlying asset allocation which can vary anywhere between 0% and 85% noting it tends to average about 65% and only spends short periods of time at the highest asset allocation. As with all our portfolios, the mandate is balanced between delivering the outcome and protecting capital, noting this portfolio will spend longer than any other invested in risky assets and will therefore be the most volatile. Global equity markets have continued to rally throughout 2017 due to strong earnings and valuations which is largely attributed to positive economic data. The markets saw volatility in Q3 following various economic and political risks, however these have seemed to disperse in Q4. As global economic data is improving and reaching record highs, from a valuation and analysis perspective, investors are relatively cautious after the volatility seen in Q3 and are questioning how long the rally will last. This is not identifying anything serious at this juncture, however we have reduced the risk element of the portfolio and increased our weighting into the nonequity, less risky assets. We will remain relatively cautious until we get clarity over the current uncertainty in the markets.

Our non-equity exposure is achieved through Global and UK High Yield and Absolute Return assets, multi asset funds that are cautious, and finally Infrastructure. We have moved the portfolios to something that has lower market sensitivity, so the holdings are now measured using volatility based equity and non-equity holdings. From an equity perspective, most of the asset allocation is achieved through a high exposure to globally managed funds with directional exposure to markets we believe show upward growth. The remaining assets are held in globally diverse funds which will be tactically rotated by the underlying fund managers with a 25% directional asset allocation to UK, Europe and Asia. We will remain underweight UK until we see better data and stability in the underlying UK economy.

In terms of equity allocation, we are holding circa 63% in equities which is still circa 4% less than the benchmark. We would expect this to fluctuate during 2017 as we take profits and only repurchase again following periods of volatility and falling valuations, in line with the mandate of the portfolio. Following this, we will rotate lesser performing assets from within the non-equity sector and add to our equity allocation.
